FEE AND TUITION REGULATIONS of the PRIGO University

Part One Introductory provisions

Article 1

1. In accordance with Article 1, paragraph 9 of the Statute of the PRIGO University, these Fee and Tuition Fee Regulations, which are internal regulations of the university, are hereby issued.
2. These rules regulate the conditions under which payments are made at the PRIGO University (hereinafter referred to as the "University"). The payments are the fees referred to in Article 2 and the tuition fees (hereinafter referred to as "tuition fees") referred to in Article 3.
3. Fees are set for each academic year. The specific method and amount of payment of fees shall be determined by the Rector by decree before the beginning of the academic year.
4. The specific method and amount of tuition fees to be paid by applicants for studies shall be determined by the Rector by decree no later than on the day of the announcement of the admission procedure conditions. By enrolling for studies, the applicant accepts the announced proposal. The details may be regulated contractually, even before enrolment.

Article 2

Fees

1. The following fees may be set at the university:
 - a) the fee for the acts related to the admission procedure to the accredited study programme,
 - b) the fee for the admission procedure to the lifelong learning programme,
 - c) the administrative fee for enrolment,
 - d) the fee for the extension of the standard period of study,
 - e) the fee for the retake or re-sit of the state final examination,
 - f) a fee for the recognition of the course or for passing the distinction examination,
 - g) the fee for the issue of the certificate of studies,
 - h) the fee for the issue of a copy of the diploma,
 - i) the fee for the extract of stamps,
 - j) the fee associated with the application for an individual study plan.

Article 3

Tuition fees

1. The following forms of tuition fee payment may be established at the university:
 - a) tuition fees per semester of study in an accredited full-time study programme,
 - b) tuition fees per semester of study in an accredited study programme in combined form,
 - c) tuition fees per semester of study in a lifelong learning programme.
2. Tuition fees may be set separately for studies in Czech or a foreign language, if the university conducts studies in these languages.
3. The student is obliged to pay the prescribed tuition fee according to the conditions specified in the relevant Rector's decree.
4. Tuition fees for a given semester may be divided into installments. The amount of the instalments and the due date shall be determined by the Rector of the university.
5. The Rector of the university may decide to reduce the tuition fee on the basis of a student's application. The Rector of the university may decide to reduce tuition fees on the grounds of outstanding academic performance or for other relevant reasons. There is no legal entitlement to a reduction in tuition fees.
6. If a student fails to pay tuition fees properly and on time, such an act is a disciplinary offence within the meaning of Section 64 of the Higher Education Act. The sanction for such a disciplinary offence is expulsion from studies in accordance with Section 65(1)(c) of the Higher Education Act. Disciplinary proceedings are not mandatory in this matter. The amount due will subsequently be forwarded for recovery.

Article 4

Final provisions

1. These Fee and Tuition Fee Regulations that have been established in accordance with the Statute of the PRIGO University were approved by the Board of Trustees on 31 May 2019.
2. These Fee and Tuition Regulations cancel the Fee and Tuition Regulations of the University of Social and Administrative Affairs registered by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports on 10 November 2017 under No.MSMT-21550/2017-5.
3. Pursuant to Sections 36(4) and 41(2) of the Higher Education Act, these Fee and Tuition Regulations come into force on the date of registration by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and come into

force on the day following the date of registration.
